AIMS OF KARAMŪ HIGH SCHOOL


Karamū High School aims to create a welcoming and stimulating learning environment where we

CURRICULUM

- Karamū High School offers extension programmes and national competitions to challenge the more able students
- Year 9 and 10 students remain within the same class for their core subjects
- Karamū High School offers students a wide variety of subject choice in response to their needs and interests
- Senior students have the choice of multiple pathways of learning. The most appropriate pathway is provided for each student
- Classes are kept as small as possible in order to provide a high quality learning environment
- All students are expected to bring a laptop to engage in a blended learning digital model
- Karamū High School has teachers that are nationally recognised in their curriculum areas

- Up-to-date resources and technology are used in our teaching and learning areas
- Karamū High School has on-going professional development to enhance the use of e-learning

Compete every year in Hawke's Bay competitions


Music tuition is available in a full range of instruments including voice.

Our athletics sports, swimming sports, cross country and house events are fun activities which emphasise participation but also provide championship events for the competitive athlete.




















